

FACTS**WHAT DOES T Bank NA, Trust Department
DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?****Why?**

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What?

The types of personal information we collect and share depends on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security number
- Retirement assets and Account balances
- Transaction history and wire transfer instructions

When you are *no longer* our customer, we may continue to share your information as described in this notice.

How?

All financial companies need to share **customers'** personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their **customers'** personal information; the reasons T Bank NA Trust Department chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

Reasons we can share your personal information	Does T Bank NA TD share?	Can you limit this sharing?
For our everyday business purposes— such as to process your transactions, maintain your account(s), respond to court orders and legal investigations, or report to credit bureaus	Yes	No
For our marketing purposes— to offer our products and services to you	No	We don't share
For joint marketing with other financial companies	No	We don't share
For our affiliates' everyday business purposes— information about your transactions and experiences	Yes	No
For our affiliates' everyday business purposes— information about your creditworthiness	No	We don't share
For non-affiliates to market to you	No	We don't share

What we do

How does T Bank NA Trust Department protect my personal information?

To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.

How does T Bank NA Trust Department collect my personal information?

We collect your personal information, for example, when you

- Open an account and give us your contact information during the account opening process
- Make deposits or withdrawals from an account
- Tell us about your investment or retirement portfolio.

Why can't I limit all sharing?

Federal law gives you the right to limit only

- sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness
- affiliates from using your information to market to you
- sharing for non-affiliates to market to you

State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.

Definitions

Affiliates

Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.

- *T Bank NA Trust Department shares information with Cain, Watters & Associates, LLC only if you currently maintain a relationship with them, otherwise we do not share with affiliates.*

Nonaffiliates

Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.

- *T Bank NA Trust Department does not share with non-affiliates so they can market to you.*

Joint marketing

A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.

- *T Bank NA Trust Department does not jointly market*
